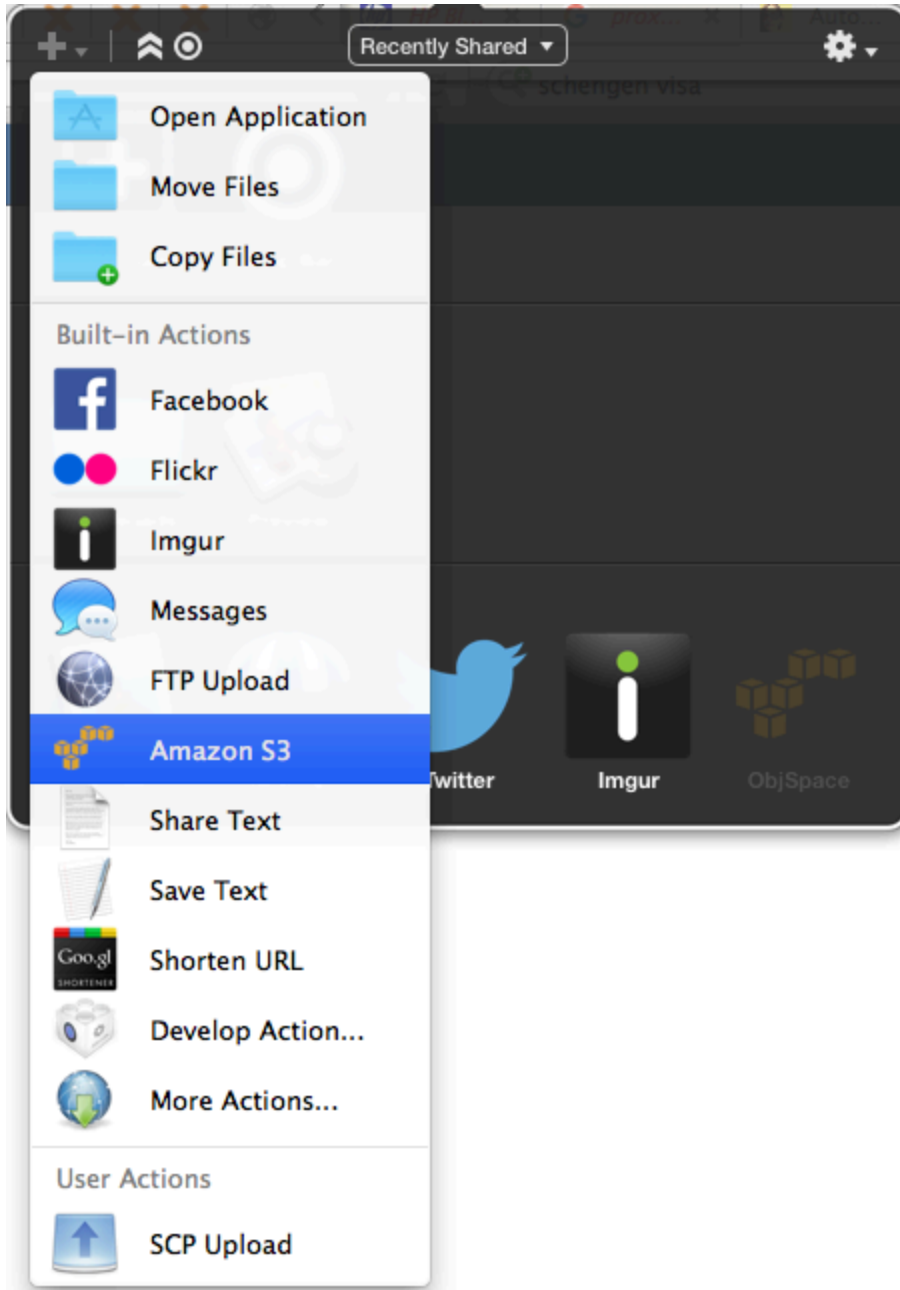


ObjSpace: Configuring Dropzone

Dropzone (<https://aptonic.com/>) is a commercial file-sharing tool for Macs. Dropzone v3 adds support for S3 compatible object stores like Delimiter's ObjSpace service.


Step-by-step guide

1. Install Dropzone v3 from their website <https://aptonic.com/>
2. Once installed, select Add new Connection -> Amazon S3



3. The 'Add Amazon S3 Action' popup will appear:

4. Enter your bucket name, Access Key, Secret key (these two keys are shown on the welcome email).
5. Click Test connection to verify its working, then Add.
